Stage Alive announces a fundraising campaign to raise \$100,000.

Donors are offered a money-back guarantee.

For 56 years, the Stage Alive Community Concert Association has been presenting top-quality professional artists to their community. They are an all-volunteer nonprofit organization committed to enriching the cultural life of seven counties in central Virginia through live performances. Stage Alive's annual concert series consists of six concerts, held in an auditorium at one of two high schools in Culpeper County.



Traditionally, revenue from season ticket sales covered operating costs; however, for several years, subscription revenue has not aligned with actual expenses. Thus, the Stage Alive Board of Directors has been forced to take the drastic step of not scheduling any more concerts until the fundraising campaign is complete. The brief fundraising campaign has a goal of \$100,000 to be raised by December 31, 2026, which will enable the Board to sustain Stage Alive for five years.



Stage Alive is so confident in its mission to continue providing high-quality musical entertainment at the lowest possible price that it is offering a money-back guarantee! If they do not meet their \$100,000 goal by December 31, 2026, for donations of \$1,000 or greater, they will refund the campaign donation. However, this will force them to cease operations, and Stage Alive Community Concert Association will no longer exist.
